Time and Space at the Ri is located at 21 Albemarle Street, across from Browns hotel. It cuts a handsome profile alongside its fashionable retail neighbours such as Paul Smith and Linley, and adds a new destination for local workers and gourmets.

Indeed, in the early 1800s, the Ri was famed for its salon-culture arising from the lectures of aristo-scientist Humphry Davy. Considerable street congestion led to Albemarle Street being designated London's first one-way carriage route.

The Ri's sharply styled new restaurant, bar, café are set to mark its new era as a social hub. The restaurant team is led by Executive Chef Anton Edelmann, Head Chef Julian Ward and General Manager Christian Kaberg.

Dining, bar, as well as extensive private events space, have been developed by digby trout Restaurants, under the direction of Baroness Susan Greenfield CBE, Director, the Royal Institution.

Library

This stylish room overlooking Albemarle Street holds an fascinating collection of scientific books and is one of our most flexible and popular rooms. The mirror above the fireplace has hung in its present position since 1804. The room benefits from natural daylight and is ideal for board meetings, presentations, training, product launches, drinks receptions, buffet lunches and formal dinners. It is often used as a catering area for those booking the theatre, and can link up with the adjoining Georgian Room for receptions over 100 people.

Writing Room

This bright and airy room is lined with books, and is perfect for small meetings, interviews and intimate gatherings or as a breakout space.

Faraday Lecture

This beautiful, historic theatre has deeply raked seating that creates an intimate atmosphere, even when full to capacity. As part of our redevelopment, it is being fitted with new seating, flooring, air conditioning, lighting and audio-visual equipment. It is also being fully redecorated, including the restoration of its rare Japanese wallpaper.

Registration for your event can be held in the Grand Entrance, with any refreshments or exhibition stands in the Ante Room, Library and Georgian Room.

Sunley Room

Situated on the ground floor, the Sunley Room is once more available for hire and is ideal for meetings, breakout space, or dinners.

Georgian Room

This unique area works well with the Library as a space for receptions and buffets. The present arrangement of the room dates from 1837 and is almost certainly the space where the Prince of Wales (later George II) came in 1717 following a massive row with his father George I.
