The Sage Gateshead, designed by Lord Foster on a landmark waterfront site, is an international home for music and musical discovery. It's creation has brought about a widespread and long-term enrichment to the landscape of the North of England.

The event team's inclusive approach enables all clients booking the venue to be involved in the creation of an event that is unique for them. With learning and participation programmes on hand for added inspiration.

Consisting of outstanding performance spaces of acoustic excellence (Hall One and Hall Two), Northern Rock Foundation Hall for rehearsal and performance, a twenty-five room Music Education Centre, ExploreMusic (a music information resource centre in the Joan and Margaret Halbert Space), The Barbour Room (a sunny entertainment room), plus studios, four bars, The Sir Michael Straker Cafe and a Brasserie.

This is a public building open from 9am - 11pm, 363 days a year (unless stated otherwise on their website). The spectacular Concourse has river views of the Tyne and Gateshead Millennium Bridges, BALTIC and the Newcastle Gateshead Quays.

### Building Closure (upon application)

For awards ceremonies and large-scale banquets it is possible to apply for a building closure, allowing use of The Barbour Room, Northern Rock Foundation Hall, Bar Foyers and the Concourse for seated dining for up to 850. Hall 1 or Hall 2 can also be used for non food consumption areas only.

### Hall One and Hall Two Bar Foyers

A total of four bars foyers, each open to the concourse catching the atmosphere of the building with fantastic views of the River Tyne.

### Large Entertainment Boxes

Eight large entertainment boxes situated around Hall One, Levels Two and Three.

### The Barbour Room

Situated behind Hall Two this is the primary function room for meetings and events. It has its own private glass balcony and a superb flat floor space for small exhibitions, breakouts or private dinners and receptions.

### Northern Rock Foundation Hall

This hall is in the centre of the building with large windows facing the River Tyne and a stunning interior.

### The Squire's Lounge

An open space off the main concourse used mainly for smaller receptions.

### The Concourse (with permission for building closure)

This spectacular area at the heart of the building can be used for high-profile seated dinners for up to 530 and commands unrivalled views of the River Tyne and Newcastle city-scape.

### Music Education Centre Rooms

Twenty-five individual rooms used for workshops, studios, a recording studio and meeting rooms.

### Seminar Room

A secure room situated next to the cloakroom, ideal for small meetings.
